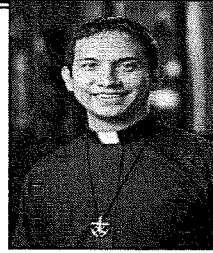

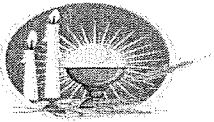
PARISH LANDSCAPING

1) Pick your chore:

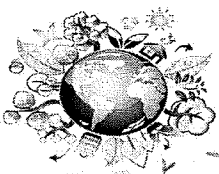
- plant grass seed
