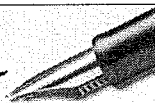
Mission Statement

Dear Parishioners,

Next Sunday, October 15, during all the Masses we will celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick. Let me make a few comments about this Sacrament. First, it is a sacrament which celebrates the healing power of Jesus Christ, both physical and spiritual. It is not only for those who are near death and both "Last Rites" and "Extreme Unction" are misnomers. The Sacrament of the Sick can rightly be received by any Catholic, who has celebrated the Sacrament of Reconciliation and whose life is seriously affected by illness, who will soon be undergoing surgery or who is affected by those infirmities which come with age. We do not usually anoint persons who have not yet celebrated the Sacrament of Reconciliation because the Sacrament of the Sick is associated with the forgiveness of sins. In past years when we have celebrated this sacrament during Mass many parishioners have taken advantage of this opportunity. I hope that will be the case again next Sunday.

We value the partnerships created with local business and acknowledge that your monies could go to countless other agencies in Grant County. CASA is a volunteer based agency. The primary role of the CASA volunteer is to provide advocacy services to children who are involved in CHINS (Child In Need of Services) court proceedings due to abuse and/or neglect. Volunteers complete an intensive and independent investigation of their assigned court-ordered case(s) in order to provide factual information to the court. They express the child's wishes and make recommendations to the court concerning the best interest of the child pertaining to safety, stability, and permanency. These children are experiencing the most difficult situations in their young lives and they depend on us to help to ensure their placement into safe, stable, permanent homes in which they can grow and thrive.
