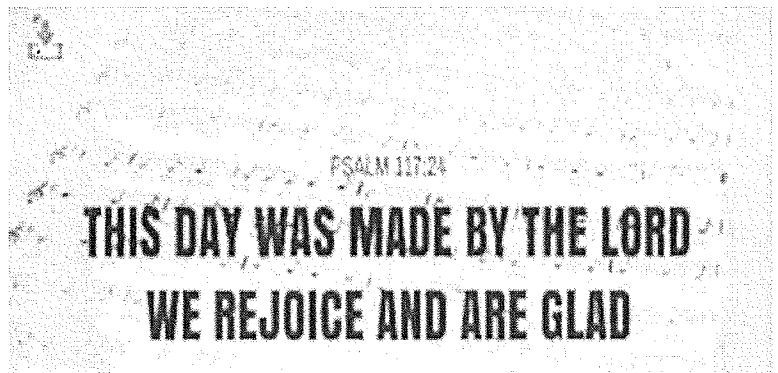

Dear Parishioners,

These men and women had their lives fundamentally changed by the Resurrection. Before Jesus rose from the dead they were fearful and ran away to save their lives. Afterwards they were willing to suffer and die for the sake of Jesus Christ. Our own faith depends largely not only on these first followers of Christ and their transformed lives but also on the way of life of men and women we have known, for example, our parents. Part of our responsibility as members of the Body of Christ is to offer that same example, that same witness to others. I hope that these 50 days of Easter will help us better witness the difference that belief in a Risen Christ makes in our lives.

TOPIC: Transforming the Culture of Death

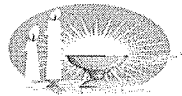
The presentation focuses into a Culture of Life on grassroots to build respect for human life at all stages.

I would like to thank you for the donation of \$550.78 to Hands of Hope, a division of Family Service Society, Inc.  
In 2018, the Flannery-Keal Home was a safe haven for 102 women, two men and 84 children. The hotline staff answered 275 crisis calls, 31 lethality calls and 138 information calls.

On the prevention side, Hands of Hope Community Education staff presented information about domestic violence, sexual violence and stalking as well as healthy relationship, respect and conflict resolution to 8,047 elementary, junior high and high school students in each of the Grant County public schools, as well as Lakeview Christian School and St. Paul Catholic School.
